

# VSMA Meeting Minutes

March 6, 2007

Mike Stokes called the meeting order at 7:10pm.

- Lanny Coggins, Sr. distributed a treasury report showing club income and expenditures since late 2006.
- Mike Stokes discussed the pits barrier. A number of ideas were suggested to replace the fence, but because of the cost involved, the general consensus was to replace the current black barrier with more of the same. Mike estimated the cost to be \$100 for 300 feet of the material.
- Craig Farrar said he has a Murray 48-inch riding mower that he would like to sell the club for \$100. He proposed the club store the mower at the field and use as necessary. After some discussion, Mike Stokes made a motion for the club to buy the mower. Craig seconded the motion, and the motion passed.
- Mike Stokes said he would bring the big roller to the field to roll the runway during the Club Work Day.
- Mike Stokes set the Club Work Day for Saturday, March 24, 2006. The club will cut the grass, roll the runway, blade the driveway, and replace the pits barrier with new material.
- Josh Bond summarized MTRCCA's March 6th meeting (the multi-club association that coordinates the large fly-ins and swap meets, beginning with last year.)
  - Ken Atwood, the Association's Chief Safety Officer, created a list of rules that will be enforced at all Association flying events to adequately protect spectators. These rules will be posted on the MTRCCA website, [www.mtrcca.org](http://www.mtrcca.org).
  - MTRCCA finalized its plans for the April 28th Fellowship Fly-In held at Peeler Park, in Madison, TN. Dick Tonan assigned people to perform certain tasks during the fly-in, such as pilot registration, radio impound, safety, parking, etc. There were enough volunteers so that no one person will have to work more than a few hours.   - MTRCCA made a verbal proposal to the Maury Airport Board to hold the huge September 7th Fly-In at the airport. The Board was very receptive to the idea and requested that MTRCCA make its request in writing so the idea can be officially approved. Absent some unforeseen circumstance arising in the next few days, the Fall Fly-In will be held at the Maury Regional Airport near Columbia, TN on September 7, 2007
